Organization Mission and/or Goals:

The Rebuilding Together Baton Rouge affiliate formed in 2003. We are a 501(c) (3) organization and one of over 130 nationwide Rebuilding Together affiliates. In October of 2004, we completed the first three home renovations. Today we have completed hundreds of projects in the greater Baton Rouge community. As we have grown locally, many organizations and corporations have supported RTBR, joining our mission through monetary donations, volunteers, and in-kind donations.

Program Mission and/ or Goals:

Our home repair services are aimed at allowing elderly or disabled low-income homeowners to stay in their homes longer. We focus on helping those most vulnerable to the rising cost of living and falling social service budgets. RTBR believes in revitalizing communities and preserving affordable homes by providing free home repairs, improvements and senior living modifications. We aim to make homes safer, more accessible and more energy efficient.

Member Position Summary:

In support of our critical home repair service, we are seeking an Outreach and Volunteer Coordinator to streamline intake processes for potential clients and volunteers. This individual will also be responsible for fostering community engagement and providing essential resources to community members as needed.

Member Impact:

At the end of the service term the Outreach and Volunteer Coordinator will have facilitated access to vital services and resources for low income homeowners facing critical home repair needs, thereby contributing to community welfare. They will have strengthened the organization's ties with the community by providing assistance and support where needed. They also will have helped expand

the organization's impact by reaching and assisting individuals who may not otherwise seek help. By fulfilling this role effectively, RTBR can better serve its mission of allowing low income homeowners to age in place.
